A program featuring contestants' pictures and bios as well as pageant information will be available at the pageant. Contestants are required to purchase one full page in the program for \$100. This page may feature the contestant or thank sponsors, family, and friends.

Contestants are encouraged to use the sale of sponsorship advertising to assist them with pageant expenses. While each page costs the contestant \$100, the advertising on the page can be sold at any price the contestant chooses. For example, 10 business card size advertisements will fit on one page. If a contestant chooses to sell business card size ads for \$25 each, the contestant would have total sales of \$250. After paying for the page, this would leave the contestant \$150 to use towards pageant expenses.

Contestants may sell as many advertising pages as they wish, but must sell at least one page. Additional pages will be \$100 for a full page and \$50 for a half page.

Send a final layout of your page exactly as you would want it to appear in the program. You may include pictures (which can be taped in place on the paper), complete the page on the computer or cut and paste business cards and type. All pages will be printed in black and white. Contestants may let their creativity run wild – as long as the page is professional and appropriate. - ◆ Contestants are not permitted to use the arenas at the center other than during horsemanship.
- ◆ You must submit a stall reservation to guarantee stall availability.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What are the wardrobe requirements?

- Orientation/Horsemanship – Wrangler pant product with form-fitting long-sleeved shirt
- Horsemanship/Rodeo Interviews, Capital Tour, and Lunch – Wrangler pant product with shirt or jacket
- Paint the Ranch Pink – Informal Fashion Show and Impromptu Questions – Wrangler pant product with shirt or jacket for Informal Fashion Show and Impromptu Questions (vests are permitted) – In addition, all contestants will need to bring black Wranglers and black hats. Miss and Teen contestants will be provided a Wrangler TETWP shirt. Princess and Sweetheart contestants will also need to bring their own pink or white shirt. Wrangler TETWP bandanas will be provided.
- Personality Interview – Western dress or skirt and jacket
- Museum Lunch and Tour – Wrangler pant product (no vests or jackets)
- Fashion Show and Speeches – Western dress or skirt and jacket
- Coronation – Western dress or skirt and jacket
- (Contestants are encouraged to wear their fashion show or interview dress for coronation.)
- Contestant's Choice – These events have no wardrobe requirements, but contestants are encouraged to remember that judges may attend any event.

2. What are the ticket prices?

Paint the Ranch Pink – \$15 for adults; \$8 for children 12 and under

Speeches and Fashion Show – \$30 for adults; \$15 for children 12 and under

Coronation – \$20 for adults; \$10 for children 12 and under

3. What is “Paint the Ranch Pink”?

Paint the Ranch Pink is a part of Wrangler’s Tough Enough to Wear Pink program. Wrangler donates shirts or bandanas to each contestant. Attendees are encouraged to wear pink to show their support for breast cancer research. Funds from this event are donated to the Susan G. Komen Foundation.

4. Will we have to carry a flag in horsemanship?

The Miss, Teen, and Princess contestants will be required to carry a flag as part of horsemanship.

Contestants must furnish their own flag boot.

5. Will noncontestants have to pay at the museum?

There is no museum fee to attend the events at the museum, but noncontestants will need to pay to go on the museum tour with the contestants. Parents, friends, and supporters are strongly encouraged to participate in this event.

6. What is the charge for breakfast?

Everyone staying at the hotel receives a free breakfast.

7. Where do I find study material for the written test and impromptu questions?

8. Where/how do I purchase programs?

Programs can be purchased during the pageant for \$5 each.

9. Are contestants required to keep their horses at Redland Community College Equestrian Center?

No, contestants can use stall arrangements of their choice including only bringing in their horse for horsemanship.
