Oklahoma **Cowgirls** on Parade

This exhibition experience will be held Saturday, September 26, 2020, in Yukon, Oklahoma, at the Canadian County Cowboy Church Arena. The goal is to gather as many Oklahoma cowgirls for a fun day of showcasing their skills. Participants will demonstrate a horsemanship pattern, speech, modeling, an impromptu question based off of their application and participate in a group interview with other participants in their age division. Age divisions, horsemanship patterns, speech topics and speech format will all follow the Miss Rodeo Oklahoma pageant rulebook.

Entry fee is \$75, and participants will receive:

- Pageant practice in this exhibition format
- Feedback sheets from qualified consultants
- Western t-shirt donated by the Fenton family
- Commemorative ball cap by Blue Line Designs
- Various other gifts

*If you would like to participate virtually, entry fee is \$50. Along with your application, you will email a video of your horsemanship pattern, speech and 30-second modeling clip to missrodeooklahomapageant@yahoo.com. These videos will not be available to the public, and you will not be participating in the group interview or impromptu question.

9:00 am – Miss Participants group interview

10 am – Horsemanship at the Canadian County Cowboy Church arena

Noon – Lunch for participants, consultants, titleholders, and volunteers at the arena and change into speech dress. Audience is on their own for lunch.

1:30 pm – Princess and Sweetheart Participants group interview

2:30 pm – Speech, modeling, and impromptu question from your application on the outdoor stage at the Canadian County Cowboy Church arena

5 pm – Teen Participants group interview

- If needing to stay all night, book a room at our host hotel the Wyndham Garden Oklahoma City Airport before September 1 for the discounted rate of \$75 a night. Hotel is located at 2101 S. Meridian Ave, Oklahoma City, OK 73108. Call 405-685-4000 and ask to book a room in the Oklahoma Rodeo Pageants Council room block.
- If needing a place to board a horse for the event, call Shelly Fitzgerald at 405-826-3167. She is located within 15 minutes of the arena. Outdoor pens are \$15 a night. Indoor stalls are \$25 a night.
- Events are free and open to the public. Social distancing is encouraged.
- IF THE OPRC DEEMS IT UNSAFE for the event to be held, the format of the event will be changed to all virtual.
- Mail application and fees in the form of a check made out to Oklahoma Rodeo Pageants Council to Oklahoma Rodeo Pageants Council, P.O. Box 6113, Enid, OK 73702 postmarked by the deadline of September 1, 2020. Late applications will not be accepted. If entering virtually, email videos to Missrodeooklahomapageant@yahoo.com
